This is a temporary position based at the Detroit warehouse.

### **Essential Duties and Responsibilities:**

1. Prepares and loads product for health-care distributions as documented on a daily printed schedule.
2. Works directly with the Healthcare Program Manager regarding schedule and routes for product deliveries.
3. Delivers product to consumer in a timely fashion.
4. Provide basic maintenance for vehicle such as maintaining vehicle in a neat and clean manner; report any necessary repairs, all accidents, damage, and malfunctions to management.
5. Transports any leftover product back to the foodbank.
6. Maintains all delivery records as instructed.
7. Apply knowledge and ability to safely load and unload deliveries according to size of load and contents.
8. Maintain and promote a high standard of cleanliness and safety.
9. Provide general assistant in the warehouse as needed.
10. Provide good customer service and maintain a professional manner and appearance to enhance the organizations image.
11. Demonstrate and support the Gleaners mission, vision and values throughout all professional responsibilities and activities.
12. Other duties as assigned.
